3	Novice Ridden - - Stallion, Mare or Gelding. Not to have won a first prize in a ridden showing class before the 1st Jan 2011. Snaffle Bridles only – exceeding 148cms.
4	M & M Small Breeds – Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, Welsh A&B, Stallion, Mare or Gelding.
5	Junior M & M Ridden – Ponies UK Rules.

52.	Novice Working Hunter Pony - Ponies 143 cms and under. Open to plaiteds and M & M's. Ponies should be presented in accordance with their breed and type. A novice is a pony that has not won a 1st prize in any working hunter class before 1st January, 2011.
53.	Novice Working Hunter Horse - Ponies exceeding 143 cms. Open to plaited horses and M&M's. Horses should be presented in accordance with their breed and type. A novice is a pony/horse that has not won a 1st prize in any working hunter class before 1st January, 2011.
54.	M & M Working Hunter - Class will start with ponies not exceeding 122 cms, followed by ponies not exceeding 138 cms, followed by ponies exceeding 138 cms. All eligible to return for the final phase.
CLEAR ROUND – runs during the lunch break Class 55 will commence at 13:00pm	
55.	Junior Working Hunter Pony - Riders to be the correct age for their pony. For ponies not exceeding 133 cms riders not to have attained their 14th birthday on 1st January, 2011.
